Re: 503B Admixtures and Latex

This memo serves as a notification to our customers receiving products compounded and/or repackaged at Avella's 503B facilities. Avella's QA Department is responsible for vendor qualifications and quality control over the FDA approved finished goods utilized in the final compounded and repackaged products at our 503B facilities. While all efforts are made to source FDA approved finished goods that are devoid of natural containing latex, occasionally, this is not possible. Typical natural latex exposure of an FDA approved finished good comes from either the stopper used in a vial, or in the manufacturing process. Avella takes great care in its use of non-consumables (tubing, syringes, etc) that are devoid of natural latex.

The chart below provides an overview of the class of products compounded and repackaged and their natural latex presentation which applies to each lot shipped. In some instances, products listed as containing latex may be a result of no information within the package insert or clear information from the manufacturer. Out of an abundance of caution, these items are listed as not being latex free.
